At our staff meeting this week, our focus was on Restorative Practices. As mentioned earlier, I will keep you updated in this area. We will be having a Parent Information Session on the 22<sup>nd</sup> July at 7pm. Put this date in your diary and I hope to see many parents at this session. It is important for you to have a good understanding of what it all means. Our presenter last night, Martin Prior, gave us this quote, and I think it really sums up the philosophy behind restorative practices: ***"The child excluded from the tribe will burn down the village to feel its warmth"***. Take some time to reflect on what that means and how important the building and repairing of relationships is in our world.

We have been having a few issues with inappropriate language coming from our students over the past few weeks. This is not just swearing, but conversations that are not appropriate, particularly at a primary school. There seems to be a lot of children accessing content online that is not meant for children. I cannot stress highly enough how important it is to know what your child is doing online. Devices should not be in bedrooms, but in a shared space. Talk to your children about what they are up to online. If they are playing Fortnite or accessing Youtube please take the time to sit with them and see what they are all about.

Thank you to the families who helped us celebrate the Prep Family Mass last Sunday. It was a beautiful celebration and a wonderful opportunity for us to come together with the families from St Anne's and Holy Trinity.

Last week was Catholic Education Week. The Year 6 captains attended Mass at St Patrick's Cathedral on Friday with thousands of students from Catholic primary and secondary schools across Melbourne. Catholic Education is alive and well in Sunbury. Yesterday we had our Parish Enrolment Information Sessions and we had close to 200 people attend. Our Open Day is next Thursday and enrolments are now open.

There are five ResourceSmart Schools modules: Core and the four resource modules of Biodiversity, Energy, Waste and Water. All modules focus on building a whole-school approach through daily operations, learning and teaching, and school community engagement.

We are currently working on the Core module. To complete this module we need to clarify the workings of our solar panels. 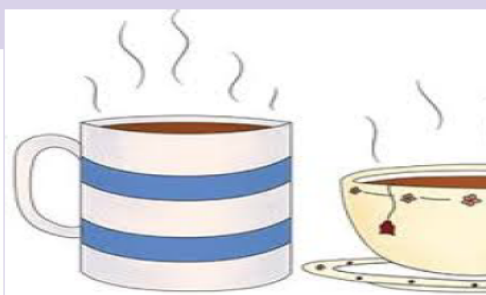
