Dear Parents,

The weeks just seem to be getting busier and busier. Thank you to the parents and grandparents who helped out with making the pancakes on Shrove Tuesday. The children had a wonderful time and learnt all about the history of the day, while enjoying delicious pancakes!

Yesterday marked the beginning of Lent with Ash Wednesday. Lent is a time where we can reflect on the things that matter the most in our lives and how there are times when we take for granted the people we love the most. It is a time to say sorry and follow in the footsteps of Jesus. It is also a time for almsgiving. What can we offer others?

The State Government has mandated that all parents are to be informed if their child is absent from school, when the absence is unreported or unexplained. In response to this Legislation we need to ensure that parents are contacting the school when their child is absent or arriving late. I urge parents to report their child's absence or late arrival via the Flexibuzz app or telephone before 9.00am. If we do not hear from you, expect a phone call. It is preferable that parents make the contact as I am sure you can appreciate that following up numerous absences will become very time consuming and expensive. If you have not downloaded the Flexibuzz app please do so now. If you have any issues, instructions are available at the office. All parents should have the app as we also us it in case of emergencies.

To assist us and also to avoid receiving unnecessary messages we ask you to do the following:

- Down load the OLMC Flexibuzz app from the app store
- * If your child is to be absent or late, let us know via the Flexibuzz app
- * If you change your contact details please notify the office immediately
- * Ensure your child is at school by 8:55 or they will be marked absent and you will be receiving a phone call

We have a number of upcoming events that I would like to bring to your attention. The PTFA have been working tirelessly behind the scenes. We will have a casual clothes day on Friday 9th March. Students are asked to bring along donations for the Easter Raffle on this day. From there, hampers will be made up and raffle tickets will be distributed to each family. The raffle will be drawn on Wednesday 28th March.

Our first big fundraiser of the year will be the OLMC Colour Run on Friday 23rd March. More details will follow very soon. It should be a great day with lots of fun and a wonderful opportunity to kick off the fundraising for the year.

Our next big event for you to mark in the calendar is the OLMC Bunnings BBQ on Saturday 31st March. More information will follow but we will be asking for volunteers to help out on the day. As it is the Easter weekend, I realise many people will be away so it is important for those of us who are around to really help out. If you are unable to attend a small cash donation would be greatly appreciated so that we can purchase the sausages, bread and drinks. Alternatively, you might like to donate some of the required items. Every little bit helps.

Please note that the PTFA meeting will now be on Monday 5^{th} March 6pm - 7pm, followed by the Board meeting 7pm - 8pm.

This Sunday we will celebrate the 1st Sunday in Lent


