Dear Parents,

Welcome back to Term 3. It seems like only yesterday we said goodbye to term 2! The first event on the calendar is our OLMC Feast Day which we are celebrating tomorrow. We will begin with Mass at 9:30am. The students will then be split into multi age groups where they will participate in a wide variety of fun activities. Thank you for the very quick response the sausage sizzle orders. A reminder there is no lunch available to be ordered from the canteen but drinks and snacks will be available. I hope you can join us in the celebrations.

This term we will be launching the Seesaw app to enhance communication between school and home. It is a student driven digital portfolio which will allow you to view the work your child is doing at school. More information will follow as to how you can access your child's profile. Please note that if your child's class currently uses dojo they will also move to Seesaw and dojo will no longer be available.

Thank you for all your fundraising help, the Parents and Friends will be helping with the purchase of Mathletics across the school. Mathletics will support our Maths program and students will be able to use it at home or at school. Each child will be given their own unique log in and teachers will give them the information they need to access the program. To begin with, students will be encouraged to log in and make themselves familiar with what is available to them. In time, teachers will be able to set tasks for the students to complete. They can also play against each other in real time to improve their automatic recall skills. I am sure they will enjoy it.

A timely reminder to be aware of what your child is doing on their device - lap top, phone, ipod, play station, etc. There are many messenger services available on these devices that you may not even be aware of. Please take the time to check in with what your child is doing and saying online and remind them to always take care with the information they are sharing with others, even if they know the person well. We will do the same at school.

SEESAW

Over the next week your child will bring home a unique QR code. This code will be needed if you use the Seesaw app on an Apple Iphone/Ipad or Android device

Please download and install the relevant app for your device.

1. Download the free Seesaw Family app for iOS or Android
2. Choose "Create Family Account"
3. Scan this QR code using Seesaw's built-in QR code scanner
4. Create your account

If you use a computer then it is web based. The instructions for computer use are below.

3. Create your account
4. Once you're approved you'll get access to Seesaw.

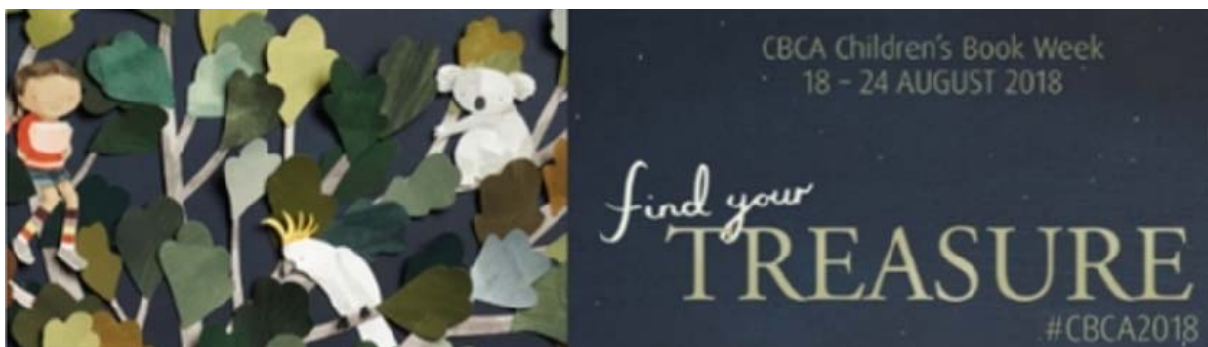
Family Book Treasure Display in Multi-Purpose Room
