
The students are very excited about having the opportunity to learn new rope/skipping skills and showing off their new learning in this area.


#### **PTFA NEWS**

#### **Enrolment Process**

To make a booking simply enroll online and once you have entered all your details you can book the sessions you need. You will need a valid credit card or bank account for direct debit. 
