Dear Parents

The school year is rapidly coming to an end. Staff allocation and class lists are just about finalised. As I know you appreciate this is a very difficult and time-consuming task. Once finalised it is impossible to change because it is not as simple as moving one child, it is all part of a very large puzzle and one movement creates a domino effect.
