Icecreams and icy poles are no longer available (T1 & T4 only)



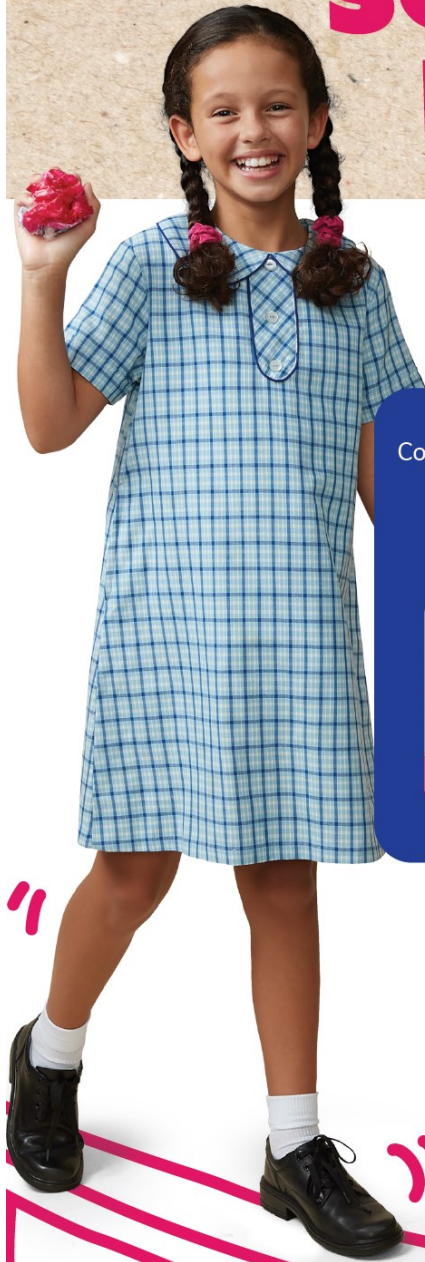
Thank you for volunteering to help in the canteen, it would be impossible without you!
