



School Uniform Policy 2023

Our Lady of Mount Carmel has a compulsory school uniform that is required to be worn by all students. The wearing of a school uniform promotes school identity, sense of community and school pride. Sports uniform and runners are only to be worn on allocated sports days.

Hair accessories are to be bottle green, yellow or white. Hair that reaches the shoulders must be tied back or up. Scarves and beanies are to be bottle green or yellow. Earrings must be studs or small sleepers and no other piercings are acceptable.. Standard watches are permitted. Please refer to our Mobile Phone and Personal Device Policy for information regarding wearable devices. Necklaces with religious pendants may be worn under the uniform. All other jewellery is to be left at home. Please note that all personal accessories are the responsibility of the owner, not the school.

(Term 1 and 4)

School dress or green school shorts and white school shirt.
School hat
Green school jumper
Black leather school shoes (not runners) - laces, buckles or velcro

(Term 2 and 3)

School tunic or green school pants or shorts with white shirt
Green school jumper
Black leather school shoes (not runners) - laces, buckles or velcro
School hat from September to May
Beanies, scarves, gloves - bottle green
Socks with summer dress - white
Socks with winter tunic or pants - green
Socks with grey pants - grey

(Sport)

School polo shirt

School rugby top

School green shorts, track pants or skirt

White socks only - no logos

Runners

A school hat is required for sport from September to May
